Built on reserved forest (120 rai)

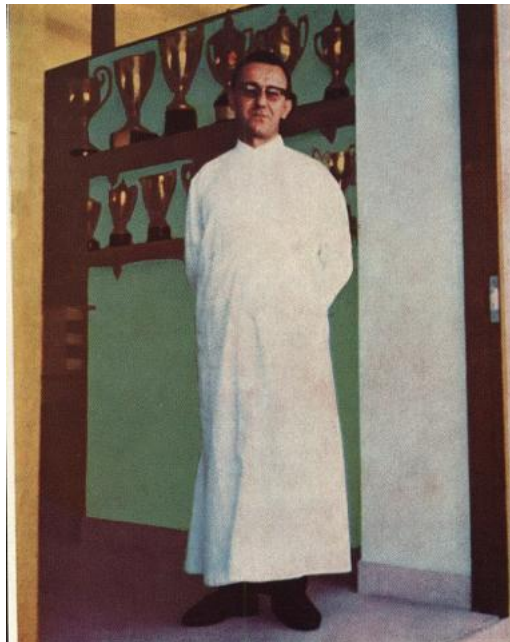
It had been attributed to three civil servants who, on the suggestion of the governor, gave up their right so that the land could be given to the St. Gabriel Foundation in order to build a school.

Brother Simeon

Days in His Life

The route map towards mentorship at ABAC

"I was a teacher in France and in England. In 1957, at the age of 26, I voluntarily came to Thailand. Then I was sent to Assumption College Sriracha for 7 years before moving on to Assumption College Rayong, when it was just about to be built. I was the one who built everything up. The other seniors thought I was keen on building schools (grins). Back then, I couldn't speak Thai but by talking to students, I'd made progress. Later on, I was appointed to be the Director of Assumption Commercial College for a year. Then I was at Assumption Nakhon Ratchasima until 1970. After being at Saint Louis University, the Philippines for 2 years, I moved to Assumption University where I am till today."

A crossover Boat

"I've been a teacher for 58 years. The more I teach, the more I enjoy (laughs). I totally agree with the Thai saying that a teacher is like a crossover boat. or in Chinese, like parents. I love this career. If I wasn't a teacher, I might be a writer because I love reading. I must read at least 10 newspapers a day. I want to share my knowledge with the others."

His Thais way

"I love Thai people, Thai lifestyle, Thai food and also Thai music. I don't think I can go anywhere else. This is sort of my home. I might go back to France but it's not my home. I feel more relaxed and comfortable here. I have lived here long enough to have received a Thai name that has a good meaning. When I picked 'Anupatt', I thought because it was different. But the monk who gave me this name told me that it means 'a suitable person to be a counselor'. See, how I walk around with this career, counseling others. I might have been destined to be like this (laughs)."

As Bro. Anupatt - Mr. counsellor for counselling

"Students today have a lot more problems than those of the old days. They think that no one cares for them or answers to their needs. But when they come to me, I would listen to them but not lead them to do anything. Anyone who has trouble must solve their own problems. A listener tends to have subjective advice so he/she shouldn't guide them. They just need a listening ear not a mouth. After being trained by Samaritans International, I'm ready to help the others in anything and don't feel reserved in any way. I believe problems can be solved. And a man couldn't be such a mean creature so as not to solve others' problems."

What you want to see develop in ABAC ?

"There is more to do in ABAC. It needs time. We, as teachers, need to think that our students are not customers. They are our raw material. We must approach them, not just sit and wait for them. We need to take care of our students and turn them into quality products for society."

To AU alumni ...

"Beyond knowledge, we want you to be a successful businesspersons who are loyal, respect yourselves, and to be responsible. You have to be confident to survive. (Smiles) Don't forget that money is important but it's not all you want. Don't be selfish. Our lives have value when we help the others."

From a French boy called Claude Petiteau, he is now Bro. Anupatt P. Yuttachai or Bro. Simeon who is still happy with a career he loves, in Thailand where he has bonded to become, his home away from home. His spirit and soul of a mentor will never fade.
