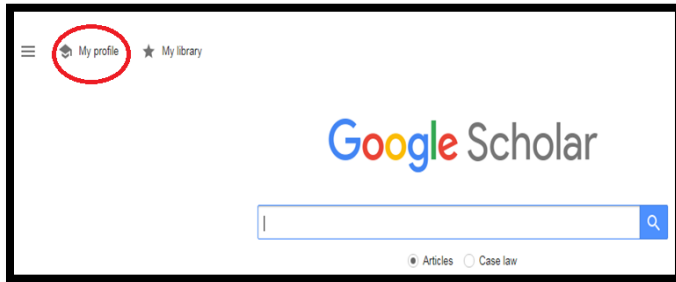


4 STEPS TO CREATE A GOOGLE SCHOLAR PROFILE



Step 1: Create your basic profile by Log on to scholar.google.com

Click the “My Profile” via AU Google Mail account (e-mail address: username@au.edu)



Step 2: Click “Profile” and insert the writer’s name

Track citations to your articles. Appear in Scholar.

This account - patcharakornspr@au.edu - is managed by au.edu. If you lose access to it, you will also lose access to your Scholar profile. To keep your profile forever, sign in to your personal Gmail account.

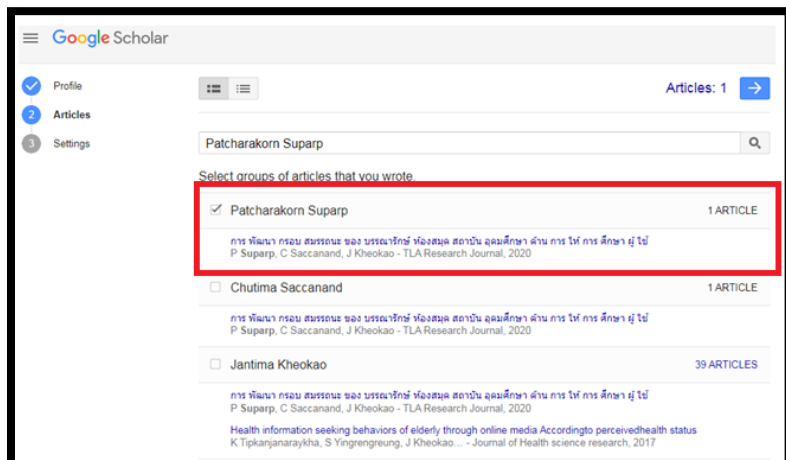

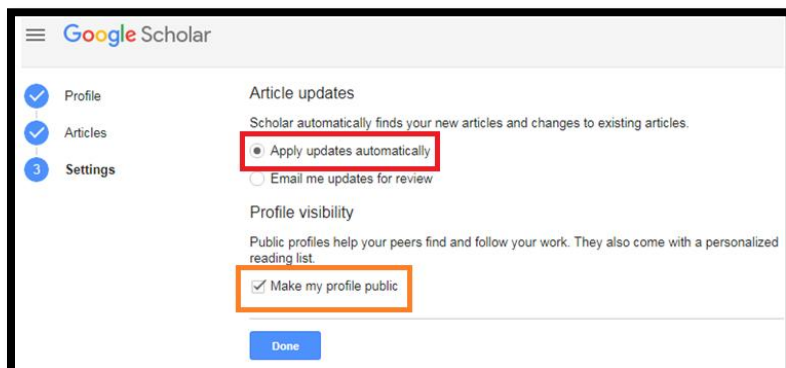
